

Travel from SLC to Delta, Utah

There are three routes to consider when traveling to Delta from Salt Lake City.

1. Travel through the historic mining town of Eureka, Utah

From Salt Lake City, access Interstate 15 southbound to Las Vegas. Take Exit 242 Santaquin. Proceed west on US 6 to Delta through the mining town of Eureka. *(131 miles, 2 hours 15 minutes)*

2. Travel Scenic Byway UT 132 from Nephi to Lyndyl, Utah

From Salt Lake City, access Interstate 15 southbound to Las Vegas. Take Exit 228 Nephi. Drive through the city center and at the stoplight turn west onto UT 132. Travel west to the junction of UT 132 and US 6. Proceed south on US 6 to Delta. *(135 miles, 2 hours 10 minutes)*

3. Travel the historic route alongside the Union Pacific rail line that brought Japanese Americans from downtown Salt Lake City to Delta, Utah

From Salt Lake City, access Interstate 80 westbound to Exit 99 Stansbury/Tooele. Proceed southbound on UT 36 for 54 miles to the junction of UT 36 and US 6. Turn right. Travel 47 miles to Delta. *(135 miles, 2 hours 15 minutes)*

All roads lead to Delta!

PLEASE NOTE: Using Google Maps or other map finders may lead you astray! We have heard horror stories from visitors. When they have typed in “Topaz Museum” as their destination, they have been directed to downtown Leamington (23 miles NE of Delta) or to the actual Topaz site (16 miles NW from Delta). Most map finders will only provide Option 2 above. You may wish to follow a road less travelled. See you soon in Delta, Utah! Happy trails...
